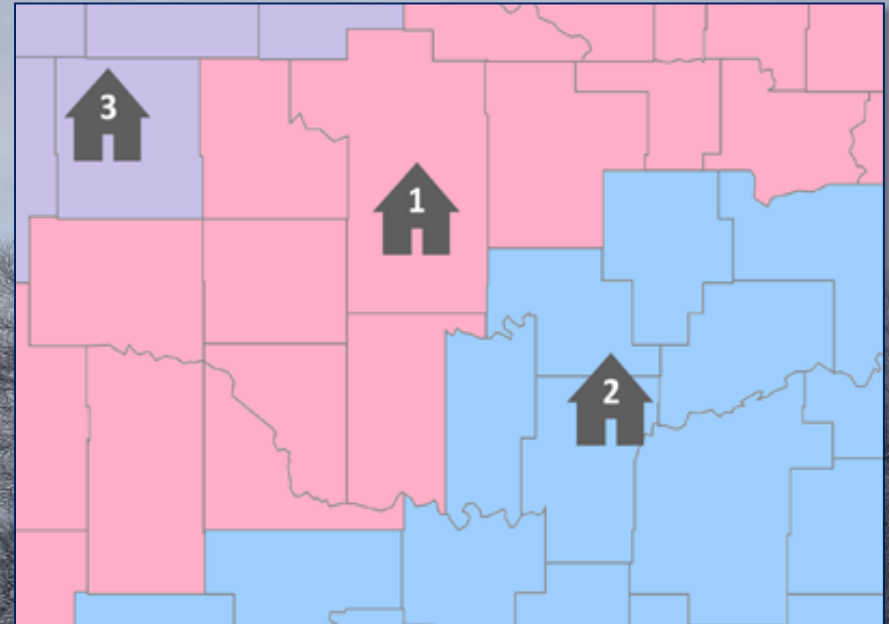

WINTER WEATHER ADVISORY: Issued when 1-3" of snow OR ice accumulation < 1/4" within 24 hours.

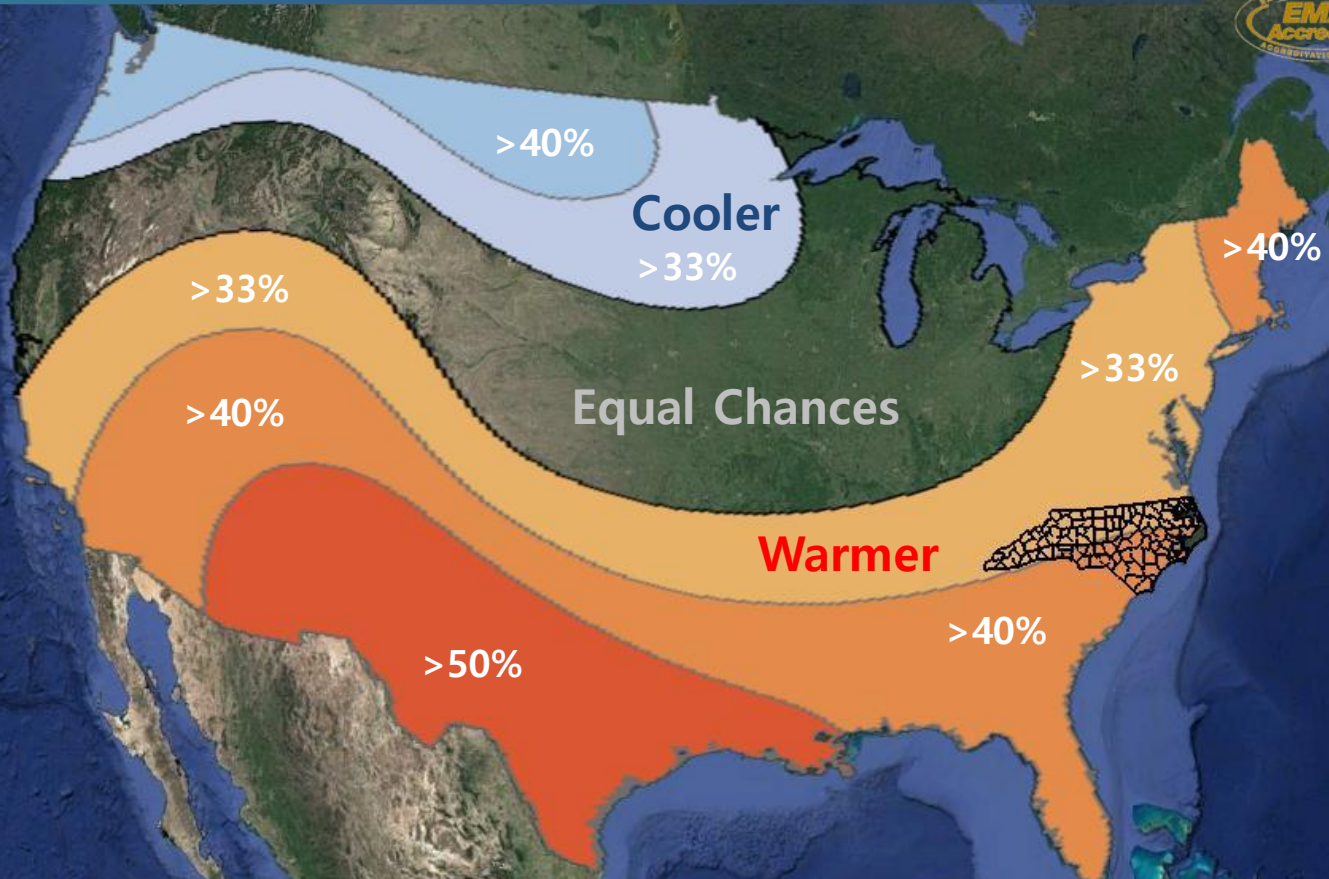
WINTER STORM WATCH: Issued when the following conditions are possible within 24-48 hours – at least 3" of snow and/or ice accumulation of 1/4" or more in a 12 – 24 hour period.

WINTER STORM WARNING: Issued when at least 3 inches of snow or ice accumulations of 1/4" or more are likely within 24 hours.



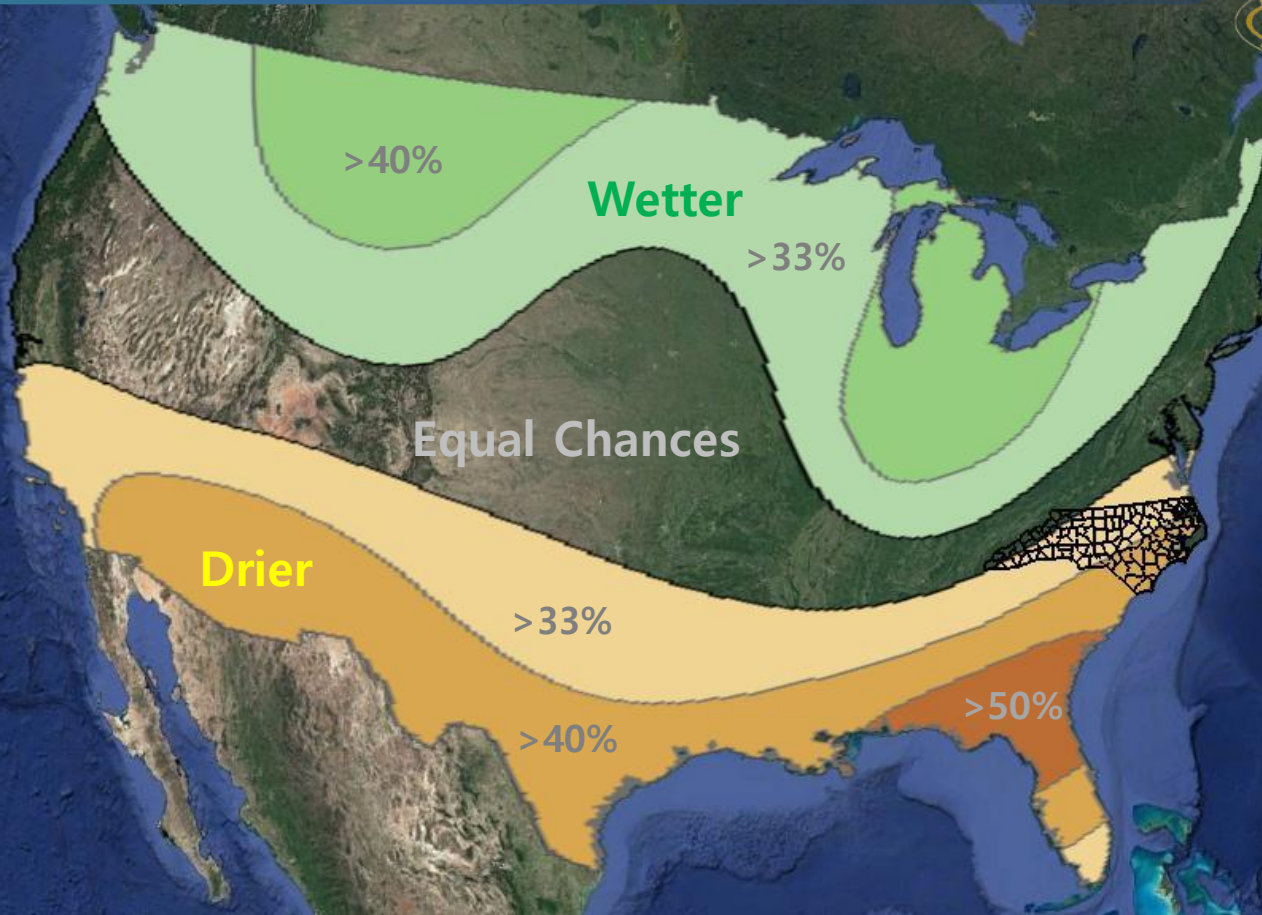
There is an increased chance of a weak La Niña developing this winter. La Niña winters are typically warmer and drier for the southern U.S. Storms typically move northward to our west during this pattern.
